It's probably the most famous date in English history... we're travelling back to 1066! We'll research the events of 1066 using books and online information and learning about how to check online information carefully. What was the Battle of Hastings, and how did it change our country? We'll discover what life was like for Norman people and dress up as Normans for the day. We'll be history detectives, looking closely at the Bayeux Tapestry and sketching parts of it. We'll use different source materials to research Norman castles and online maps to locate them. In English, Year 3 will be using the text 'I Was There... 1066' to spark writing ideas related to this fascinating period in history and Year 4 will be focusing their literacy work around 'Norman the Norman from Normandy'.

At the end of our learning journey, we'll think about what the Normans did for us and aim to complete a project creating our own castle and share our learning with you.
