5. Evaluate and review: encourage pupils to develop well-founded reasons and justify their conclusions or views. pupils from the outset in 'big questions' to provide a context for carrying out an investigation to answer their own questions, drawing on previous learning.

4. Reflect and respond: integrate opportunities for reflection throughout the process of enquiry, enabling them to deepen their knowledge and understanding.

> 3. Interpret and analyse: provide first hand experience and give pupils access to examples of living religious practice to stimulate pupils' leaning.

2. Investigate: use a multidisciplinary approach to deepen learning and extend pupils' investigations into religion and other worldviews, looking through different lenses.
